Objectives

Upon completion of the course, the student will:

- be able to analyse a company, its operations, and international relations
- be able to plan a company's strategic, tactical, and operative business
- be able to determine if the operations continue according to plan and take appropriate action
- have good knowledge of different management theories,
- understand the difference between decision-making and operational effectiveness and the consequences for the implementation of resolved actions.

Content

The following topics will be included in the course:

- Leadership and TQM (Total Quality Management)
- Business management and decision-making including risk management, an overview
- Present-time analysis
- Goal analysis
- Strategic planning
- Implementation – action
- Data collection and information handling

Examination

Requirements for examination

Two written tests and group work.

Passing grades on the exams, approved group work and participation in the compulsory activities.
