Objectives

The course will give knowledge in Laboratory in Animal Science including experimental planning, legislation, the use of rats, other mammals and fish in biomedical research.

Content

Lectures and theoretical and practical group exercises are the base for this course. The course covers legislation and regulations in laboratory animal science.

Implementation

The course implementation includes lectures, video films, practical exercises (handling, techniques and autopsies), group exercises with presentations and visits to laboratory animal facilities.

Formats and requirements for examination

Passed home exam and passed participation in the compulsory parts of the course.

- If the student fails a test, the examiner may give the student a supplementary assignment, provided this is possible and there is reason to do so.
- If the student has been granted special educational support because of a disability, the examiner has the right to offer the student an adapted test, or provide an alternative assessment.
- If changes are made to this course syllabus, or if the course is closed, SLU shall decide on transitional rules for examination of students admitted under this syllabus but who have not yet passed the course.
- For the examination of a degree project (independent project), the examiner may also allow the student to add supplemental information after the deadline.
