Objectives

Upon completion of the course, the student will have basic abilities in applied accounting. The different concepts and methods of accounting and the consequences of taxation and financial decisions to are included in the course.

Content

The course is split into two parts: Accounting and financing.

The main part is the accounting part, in particular the fundamental principles of accounting. The external accounting is treated. The accounting is a part of the information system of the firm and is an essential tool for evaluation and control of the company. The course is concrete and the content is possible to apply directly. Some of the areas are: accounting, commodity transactions, wage cost accounting, taxation accounting and valuation rules. Financial aspects are treated.
