Objectives

Having completed the course, the student will have received an introduction to academic studies and scientific methodology, as well as tools for the following academic studies and awareness of the public role of SLU.

Content

- A general introduction, "tools for academic studies", corresponding to 2 Swedish University Credits (SUC), is included during the 1st year of the curriculum and consists of welcome activities, a study tour, introduction to the library and the computer lab, learning techniques, etc. These components are integrated with Introduction to Veterinary Anatomy and Basic Medical Biology.
- The SESAM-days, 1 SUC, are given for all 1st year students on SLU's long-term programmes. The SESAM week brings students together from different educational programmes and gives an overall view of the width and disciplinary responsibilities of SLU.
- An introduction to scientific writing and oral presentation, writing of an individual essay, oral presentation and opposition, corresponding to 3 SUC, are integrated with other courses during the 1st year. The SESAM-themes are used for this training.

Implementation

The course content is adapted to the on-going disciplinary courses. 1 SUC has its own concentrated week (the SESAM-days in the 1st year) while the other components, corresponding to 5 credit points, are co-ordinated/integrated with other courses and components of the curriculum during the 1st year.

Examination**Requirements for examination**

According to Contents.

Individual essay, oral presentation and opposition, as well as participation in compulsory activities.

- If the student fails a test, the examiner may give the student a supplementary assignment, provided this is possible and there is reason to do so.
- If the student has been granted special educational support because of a disability, the examiner has the right to offer the student an adapted test, or provide an alternative assessment.
- If changes are made to this course syllabus, or if the course is closed, SLU shall decide on transitional rules for examination of students admitted under this syllabus but who have not yet passed the course.
- For the examination of a degree project (independent project), the examiner may also allow the student to add supplemental information after the deadline. For more information on this, please refer to the regulations for education at Bachelor's and Master's level.
