PhD students in medical biochemistry, veterinary medicine, molecular biosciences or similar background.

Objective, including learning outcomes

To gain insight in basic principles of biochemistry, cellular and molecular biology and relate them to current topics in biomedical research.

Content

At the meetings, a predefined section of the course book is presented by one participant, who is also expected to relate the contents to current topics in his/her own research. These topics are then discussed among the students and teachers. Each student is expected to have read the relevant parts of the course book before each meeting.

Requirements for examination

Successful completion requires minimum 80% attendance, active presentation and discussion during meetings, and completion and submission of a course assignment.

Additional information

The course will be held between 16 and 17 every second Tuesday, starting 8/12 and continuing during the spring semester 2010. A detailed schedule will be distributed at the first meeting.
