## Objective, including learning outcomes

The course covers many aspects on the tubular genitalia in female domestic animals such as morphology, morphological techniques, clinical examination including

pregnancy diagnosis, immunology, endocrinology, the post partum period and treatments of endometritis. Comparative aspects between different species will be discussed as well as the risk of multi-resistance towards antibiotics.

### **Content**

Lectures and practical demonstrations, general discussions, student presentations.

### **Requirements for examination**

Attendance compulsory; individual oral presentations.

### **Additional information**

The course in Uppsala takes place 8-12 June, 2009, and it will be very intensive with long days and evening activities.

Before the course the participants have to prepare a presentation on their research project. During the course they will actively reflect on the daily information given and compile a generic summary and present it. They will also be assigned tasks that should be done afterwards and sent in as a written report. Therefore the course is given 3 ECTS.
