Objectives

The aim of the practical experience at commercial veterinary enterprises is to allow the student, already during the study period, to become acquainted with environments, working methods and the medical problems that may be encountered at animal hospitals/animal clinics. The time spent at the clinic will also give the student opportunities to apply theoretical knowledge in animal nursing.

Content

Theoretical part:

- project work with written report

Practical parts:

- personal hygiene, cleaning and disinfecting, waste handling
- handling and methods of restraint. Nutrition of hospitalized patients.
- medication, treatment and bandaging techniques
- assistance in examinations, treatments, euthanasia
- anaesthesia, pre- and perioperative care; sterile and non-sterile
- intensive care, post-operative care
- assistance at emergency slaughter
- radiological examinations, large and small animals
- administrative routines in reception, contacts with animal owners
- knowledge and care of instruments, store management
- laboratory knowledge.

Implementation

Practical work at an animal hospital, and the student's own project work.

Examination

Requirements for examination

Written/oral examination, practical tests, passed project work.

Passed examination, passed practical tests, participation in all compulsory parts of the course, and approved completion of tasks allotted.

- If the student fails a test, the examiner may give the student a supplementary assignment, provided this is possible and there is reason to do so.
- If the student has been granted special educational support because of a disability, the examiner has the right to offer the student an adapted test, or provide an alternative assessment.
- If changes are made to this course syllabus, or if the course is closed, SLU shall decide on transitional rules for examination of students admitted under this syllabus but who have not yet passed the course.
- For the examination of a degree project (independent project), the examiner may also allow the student to add supplemental information after the deadline. For more information on this, please refer to the regulations for education at Bachelor's and Master's level.

Additional information

- The right to take part in teaching and/or supervision only applies to the course date to which the student has been admitted and registered on.
