Prior knowledge

The equivalent of the courses "Environmental Ecology", 10 cr, and "Environment, People and Society", 10 cr, which are given within the programme Soil Science and Environmental Studies.

Objectives

The course should train the discussion and analysis of environmental topics, with particular attention to their multidisciplinary character. Further, the course should promote ideas for student thesis topics.

Content

The course brings up current environmental topics. Course elements are 1) invited lectures combined with seminars, 2) panel debates on specified topics, 3) study visits, 4) essay-writing and, 5) work with exhibitions on environmental topics.

Implementation

The course is intermittent, running parallel with other courses, throughout semesters 2-7, in the study programme (appr. 8 Wednesday afternoons per semester).

Examination**Requirements for examination**

Registered participation for a minimum of 5 semesters, and including at least 25 scheduled activities.

Approved performance as above.

- If the student fails a test, the examiner may give the student a supplementary assignment, provided this is possible and there is reason to do so.
- If the student has been granted special educational support because of a disability, the examiner has the right to offer the student an adapted test, or provide an alternative assessment.

- If changes are made to this course syllabus, or if the course is closed, SLU shall decide on transitional rules for examination of students admitted under this syllabus but who have not yet passed the course.
- For the examination of a degree project (independent project), the examiner may also allow the student to add supplemental information after the deadline. For more information on this, please refer to the regulations for education at Bachelor's and Master's level.

Additional information

The course is given in cooperation with the Umeå School of the Environment. It is open for students taking any of the master programmes within the Umeå School of the Environment.
