Prior knowledge

Knowledge equivalent to English B from upper secondary school is required as from the academic year 2009/10.

Approved independent project at basic level and 30 credits at advanced level including the course Stakeholder Facilitation in Project and Conflict Management, 15 hp, or equivalent.

Knowledge equivalent to english A from upper secondary school.

Objectives

The student will be able to:

- Describe and reflect on his or her experiences in working with an Environmental Communication project.
- Asses in written form, based on reference literature and course lectures, a communicative process, with special focus on communication strategies and process management.
- Critically reflect on the earlier made research proposal for a practice-oriented research, adjust if needed and motivate the adjustments in written form.
- Apply interviewing and process-oriented methods as research methods.

Content

The course forms the conclusion of the one-year master in Environmental Communication and Management. In this course students write a thesis based on experiences from practise and auscultation in an organisation. The organisation should work with environmental communication, thus be interacting with other people about their use of natural resources, e.g. carry out environmental control, advisory, constituting nature reserves, facilitating local management. Students will participate in and/or observe the daily activities in the organisation or a part of the organisation with a specific focus on how external and internal communication is carried out. The students will write about their observations and their reflections, based in communicative theory. The students will meet each other regularly during the practice period and reflect about their experiences. They will also be supervised.

Examination

Requirements for examination

Project work presentation.
