Passed examinations from all courses of the 1st, 2nd and 3rd years of the Study Programme in Veterinary Medicine.

Objectives

Having completed the course, the students will have gained basic knowledge of surgical principles before they attend the clinical courses of small and large animal surgery.

Content

Basic surgical concepts, tissue handling and principles of therapy in the horse, dog and, to a minor extent, also the cat.

Implementation

The course comprises a series of 16 lectures.

Examination

Requirements for examination

A written examination will be held after the course.

Passed examination and participation in compulsory items.

- If the student fails a test, the examiner may give the student a supplementary assignment, provided this is possible and there is reason to do so.
- If the student has been granted special educational support because of a disability, the examiner has the right to offer the student an adapted test, or provide an alternative assessment.
- If changes are made to this course syllabus, or if the course is closed, SLU shall decide on transitional rules for examination of students admitted under this syllabus but who have not yet passed the course.
- For the examination of a degree project (independent project), the examiner may also allow the student to add supplemental information after the deadline. For more information on this, please refer to the regulations for education at Bachelor's and Master's level.

The course is part of Clinical Activities – Sport and Companion Animals, 4th year.

- The right to take part in teaching and/or supervision only applies to the course date to which the student has been admitted and registered on.
