Prior knowledge

Three years of studies at the MSc in Forestry programme (180 credits) as well as 22,5 ECTS in Organization and leadership or comparable knowledge.

Objectives

After completion of the course, the student:

- will have good understanding of analytical leadership and organisational development work in a for the student relevant company or organisation
- will be able to apply knowledge gained during the education programme.

Based on the contacts in the company/organisation, the student will be able to relate organisation teoretical concepts and theories to conditions and actions found in reality.

Content

Based on organisation and leadership tehories, the project will contain one more of the following work assignments:

- The organisational structure and its change over time.
- The informal organisation/ organisation culture and its change over time
- A description of how the organisation deals with changes in the external environment - for example future demands of interest groups, future technological developments etc.

Implementation

The project is conducted in cooperation with a company/organisation relevant for the student´s education. Contact betseen the advisor at the host company/organisation and the advisor at the faculty will provide good conditions for interaction between theory and practice. A report on the project is written and presented at a seminar.

Report writing ca 8 days

Preparation of the presentation and opposition on another project report ca 2 days

Seminar - presentation and opposition on project work ca 2 days (compulsory)

Formats and requirements for examination

- If the student fails a test, the examiner may give the student a supplementary assignment, provided this is possible and there is reason to do so.
