Prior knowledge

The equivalent of: the course Animal Breeding and Genetics (15 Swedish University Credits, SUC), or Nutritional Physiology and Feed Science (15 SUC), or Animal Husbandry - review course (5 SUC).

Objectives

The students will get an opportunity to:

- get an insight into various types of animal husbandry/production in Sweden or some other country
- get deeper insights in current conditions and issues in agriculture and animal production through discussions with farmers and representatives from the livestock industry
- plan the study tour and write a travel report.

Content

The course includes study visits to farmers having dairy cattle, beef cattle, pigs, sheep, goats, poultry, etc., to illustrate various production systems. Enterprises with production of sport and pet animals may also be visited. Furthermore, visits are paid to research institutions and /or service enterprises in the livestock industry.

Participation in the planning and in the study tour. Approved travel reporting in written form and orally.

The study tour may be within Sweden and/or abroad. The sites to visit are decided by the students in consultation with the departments responsible. The study tour is largely financed by the students.
