## Objective, including learning outcomes

Upon successful completion of the course participants will be able to make use of standard regression analysis techniques, such as linear and logistic regression,

and to analyze and critically examine the results. The participants also will gain introductory knowledge on nonlinear regression, generalized linear models and mixed effects models.
