**Objectives**

After completion of the course, the student:

- will have good understanding of analytical leadership and organisational development work in a for the student relevant company or organisation
- will be able to apply knowledge gained during the education programme.

Based on the contacts in the company/organisation, the student will be able to relate organisation theoretical concepts and theories to conditions and actions found in reality.

**Content**

Based on organisation and leadership theories, the project will contain one more of the following work assignments:

- The organisational structure and its change over time.
- The informal organisation/ organisation culture and its change over time
- A description of how the organisation deals with changes in the external environment - for example future demands of interest groups, future technological developments etc.
